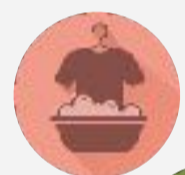


CONFINEMENT CENTER



WHY THIS CENTRE ?

When someone **HAS OR IS SUSPECTED** of having COVID-19, she/he has to **SELF-ISOLATE** in order not to spread the virus. For certain people this is not easy because they do not have the appropriate space or they share their living space with other people. The confinement centres are especially for homeless people or for people who live in communal spaces and need to self-isolate.



WHAT IS INSIDE?

Upon your arrival, you will have a general medical check-up, then a team of doctors and nurses will look after you every day. You also have access to a bed, a shower, laundry service, free food (Hallal), leisure activities, wifi and long distant calls.

HOW LONG SHOULD YOU STAY?

If you have COVID-19 or you are a high-risk contact, you should stay and not go out in the street or to your shelter for 10 days, extendable depending on your symptoms. Inside the centre, COVID-19 positive residents and those awaiting test results are separated.

HOW TO GET THERE?

It is not possible to enter the centre by showing up at the gate yourself. If you feel sick, inform people in your shelter or go to the HUB or Athena. After a medical examination, if the doctor thinks it might be COVID-19, you will be referred there.
